To Stakeholder, Property Owner, and/or Tenant:

You are receiving this notification because you live on or own property adjacent to Exposition Boulevard in Austin, Texas, and/or are a stakeholder in the area.

In order to address traffic congestion and air quality, the City's Public Works Department is implementing a bicycle route system, as directed by the Austin City Council per City Ordinance No. 980507-D (The Austin Bicycle Plan). Exposition Boulevard from Lake Austin Boulevard to West 35th Street is Route 25 of the City of Austin Bicycle System.

To improve mobility in the corridor for both motor vehicles and bicycles, the corridor will be re-surfaced and re-striped and on-street motor vehicle parking will be permitted on one side of Exposition Boulevard only, as follows:

Lake Austin Blvd. to Westover Rd. – Parking Permitted on EAST SIDE only
Westover Rd. to West 35th St. – Parking Permitted on the WEST SIDE only

Please note that additional parking restrictions will be required at signaled intersection approaches for both sides of Exposition Boulevard. Additionally, left turn lanes will be added to Exposition at the intersection of Enfield Road. The left turn lanes and bicycle lane modifications at the intersection will improve traffic flow and mobility for both motor vehicles and bicycles.
