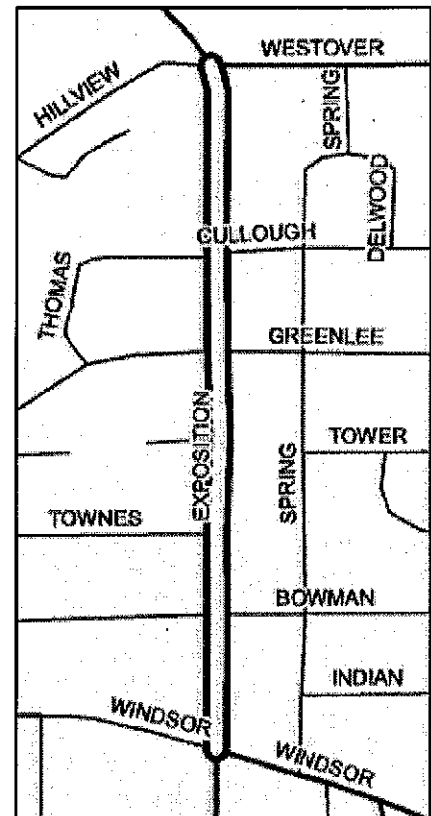
To Stakeholder, Property Owner, and/or Tenant:

You are receiving this notification because you live on or own property adjacent to Exposition Boulevard in Austin, Texas, and/or are a stakeholder in the area.

In order to address traffic congestion and air quality, the City's Public Works Department is implementing a bicycle route system, as directed by the Austin City Council per City Ordinance No. 980507-D (The Austin Bicycle Plan). Exposition Boulevard from Windsor Road to Westover Road is part of Route 25 of the City of Austin Bicycle System.

To install bicycle lanes the following parking modifications are required:

- **No Parking from 7am to 7pm** zone will be added on the east and west sides of Exposition Boulevard from Windsor Road to Verde Vista and from 370' south of Westover Road to Westover Road.
- **No Parking from 7am to 7pm except Sunday** zone will be added on the east and west sides of Exposition Boulevard from Verde Vista to Greenlee Drive and from McCullough Street to 370' south of Westover Road.
- **No Parking from 7am to 10am and 4pm to 7pm Monday through Friday** zone will be added on the east and west sides of Exposition Boulevard from Greenlee Drive to McCullough Street.
