To Stakeholder, Property Owner, and/or Tenant:

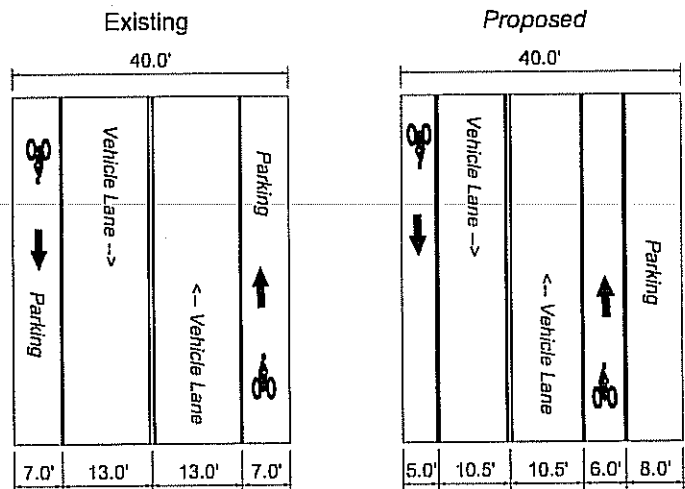
You are receiving this notification because you live on and/or own property adjacent to Mary Street in Austin, Texas, and/or are a stakeholder in the area.

In order to address traffic congestion and air quality, the City's Public Works Department is implementing and improving a bicycle route system, as directed by the Austin City Council per City Ordinance No. 980507-D (The Austin Bicycle Plan). Mary Street from Congress Avenue to Lamar Boulevard is Route 68 of the City of Austin bicycle system.

In coordination with routine road re-surfacing and re-striping, and to improve mobility in the corridor for both motor vehicles and bicycles, the street striping will be reconfigured. These modifications are to provide delineated on-street parking areas, bicycle lanes, and to improve corridor mobility and safety.

To accomplish this, current on-street motor vehicle parking restrictions will be retained and expanded on Mary Street. The parking restrictions are as follows:

- **Mary St.** (S. Congress Ave to S. 1st St) – parking modification is to prohibit parking on the north side of the street
- **Mary St.** (S. 1st St to S. 7th St) – parking modification is to prohibit parking on the south side of the street
- **Mary St.** (S. 7th St to S. Lamar Blvd) – parking modification is a slight extension of the existing parking prohibition on both sides of the street for safety and mobility reasons.



The corridor's safety and mobility, as well as the results of an on-street parking use analysis were considered to determine the parking restrictions listed above.
