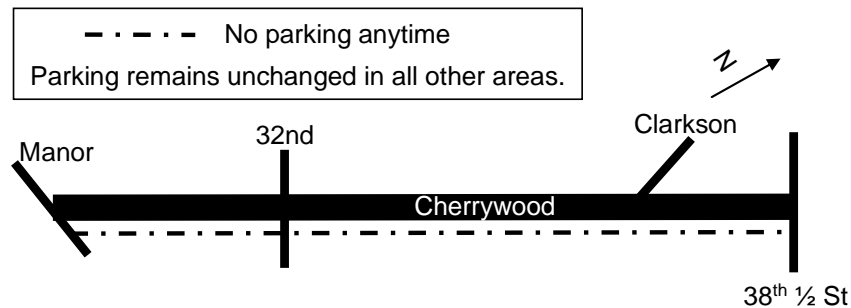
You are receiving this notification because you live on and/or own property adjacent to Cherrywood Road in Austin, Texas, and/or are a stakeholder in the area.

In order to address traffic congestion and air quality, the City's Public Works Department is implementing and improving a bicycle route system, as directed by the Austin City Council per **City Ordinance No. 20090611-075 (The Austin Bicycle Plan)**. Cherrywood Road from Manor Road to 38 ½ Street is part of Route 59 of the City of Austin bicycle system.

In coordination with routine street maintenance (road re-surfacing and re-striping), and to improve mobility in the corridor for both motor vehicles and bicycles, the street striping will be reconfigured to include bicycle lanes. To accomplish this reconfiguration, on-street motor vehicle parking will be prohibited on certain sections of Cherrywood Road. The corridor's safety and mobility, as well as the results of an on-street parking use analysis, were considered to determine these parking modifications:

- **Cherrywood Rd** (Manor Rd to 38 ½ St) –prohibit parking on the east side of the street.
